(HOUSTON) April 10, 2023 – More than 20 vulnerable kittens and puppies are currently in the Houston SPCA’s neonatal nursery staying warm and being gently hand fed every few hours as the rescue and protection organization is expecting to care for hundreds this Spring. The

lifesaving nursery is critical for these babies until they are stable enough to go into foster before they are prepared for adoption which includes spay or neuter surgery, up-to-date vaccinations and a microchip.
